Director of Christian Education Bible Study By Pat Byers "Turn Down the Noise" - - - Psalm 46: 10-11

I have been convicted. In the busyness and fast-paced'ness I have fallen into, I'm struggling to get quiet. I'm struggling to hear. I'm struggling to get the volume knobs in the right place. My knob for screens and news and sports and email and work is often turned way too loud. And my knob for the voice of God is often way too soft. And the thing about God is, He's never going to step in and change that. He leaves that up to me.

I want to be different. I want to be more intentional. Maybe it means getting up earlier. Perhaps it means being more prayerful in my use of time. Maybe it's even deeper. I wonder if it's really about surrender? Like I'm going through the God motions on the outside, but as I start to look inward, I begin to realize that I may really be trying to keep him at bay. Like I am afraid of what He will say if I really crawl into his lap and listen.

I wonder how we can collectively do this as a body of Christ, living in different places and living out different circumstances. What would it take for us to have our communal WYM volume knobs set right?

The Psalmist said "Be still and know that I am God." I want to know that God. I'm committing to Be Still, so I can. Will you join me in this commitment?

He says "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth

Calling All WYM Quaker Men

Remember the great job we did raising money for John Muhanji's vehicle? Well, we have another great opportunity. Quaker Men International has pledged to raise 1,000,000 shillings for a loan fund at Friends Theological College in Kaimosi, Kenya. North American Quaker Men have agreed to that amount in a match with the Kenyan Quaker Men.

The fund will provide loans to students at FTC to get started in a business that will allow them to pay their college fees. The student must present to the college a viable business plan in order to get the loan. When the loan is repaid, the money will be available for loan to another student down the line.
